MOST HOLY TRINITY

In Trinitarian doctrine, God exists as three persons, but is one being, having a single divine nature. The members of the Trinity are co-

equal and co-eternal, one in essence, nature, power, action, and will. the Father is uncreated, the Son is uncreated, and the Holy Spirit is uncreated, and all three are eternal without beginning. "The Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit" are not names for different parts of God, but one name for God because three persons exist in God as one entity. They cannot be separated from one another. Each person is understood as having the identical essence or nature, not merely similar natures

Baptism is generally conferred with the Trinitarian formula, "in the name of the father, and of the son, and of the holy spirit".

June 11th

SAINT BARNABAS

Apostle

Though not one of the Twelve, St. Barnabas is considered an Apostle by the church. He was a Jew of the tribe of Levi, from Cyprus. He came to



Jerusalem where he joined the early Christian community. His success in preaching prompted the Apostles to change his name of Joseph to Barnabas, which means "son of encouragement. It was Barnabas who accepted the recently converted and former persecutor of the church, Saul, and set him, on the path to becoming the great Apostle Paul by introducing him to the Apostles. Barnabas was at Paul's side for many years preaching the Faith to Gentiles. Tradition has it that he was stones to death in his native Cyprus.

God, You commanded that St. Barnabas, who was full of Faith and the Holy Spirit, should be set apart to labour for the conversion of the Gentiles. May Christ's Gospel, which he preached with great ardor, continue to be preached faithfully by word and deed. Amen. *****************

June 13th

SAINT ANTHONY OF PADUA

St. Anthony was a native of Lisbon, Portugal, where he was born in 1195. He received the name Ferdinand at baptism. He was educated by the Order of regular Canons of St. Augustine



and joined them at the age of 15. After 2 years he was sent to the convent of the Holy Cross where he was for 8 years, when the relics of five Franciscan martyrs were brought from Morocco to Portugal. This inspired St. Anthony to follow into the footsteps of these heroes of Faith. He obtained permission to pass over to the Franciscan Order. He was on his way to preach in Africa, but severe illness forced him to return. Winds drove the vessel to Sicily and the desire to see St. Francis took him from there to Assisi. After teaching for many years in Bologna, Toulouse and Padua, he devoted himself to the work of preaching. Through his

sermons he saved many souls. Though he was denied a martyrs death, he was regarded during his lifetime a saint and many miracles were attributed to him. The most famous one is the story of his host, when looking through the window, seeing St. Anthony holding the Child Jesus in his arms. He is called St. Anthony of Padua on account of his log residence in that city.

Almighty God, You have given St. Anthony to Your people as an outstanding preacher and a ready helper in time of need. With his assistance may we follow the Gospel of Christ and experience Your help in every difficulty. Amen.
