## June 22<sup>nd</sup> STS JOHN FISHER AND THOMAS MORE

ST. JOHN FISHER was born in Beverly, Yorkshire in 1459. His studies at Cambridge were so excellent, that he was ordained by special permission when he was just 22 years old. In 1504



he was made Bishop of Rochester and Chancellor of Cambridge. in which capacity he also tutored Prince Henry, who was to become King Henry VIII. St. John was a humble servant dedicated to the welfare of his diocese and his university. St. John, Erasmus and Thomas More became great friends, actively opposing the King's divorce from Catherine of Aragon, he was imprisoned in the Tower of London in April 1534. 1535 he was made Cardinal by Pope Paul III. King Henry retaliated by having him beheaded within a month.



ST. THOMAS MORE was born in London in 1478. After thorough grounding in religion and the classics, he entered Oxford to study law, was called to the bar in 1501 and 3 years later he entered Parliament. In 1505 he married Jane Colt who bore him four children. An enlightened man, he insisted

that his 3 daughters receive the same education as his son. After Jane's death Thomas married a widow. Alice Middleton to be a mother to his young children. This learned man attracted the attention of King Henry the VIII, who appointed him to many high posts and made him Lord Chancellor in 1529, however he resigned in 1532, when Henry persisted in holding his own opinions regarding marriage and the supremacy of the Pope. In 1534, with his close friend John Fisher, he refused to render alliance to the King as Head of the Church and was confined to the Tower of London. Fifteen days after the execution of John Fisher he was convicted of treason and was beheaded on July 6, 1535. St. Thomas More is Patron of Lawyers.

God, You consummated the form of the true Faith in martyrdom. Through the intersession of Sts. John and Thomas, grant that we may confirm by the testimony of our lives that Faith which we profess with our tongues. Amen.

# BIRTH OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST

On this feast day, one of the oldest in the liturgy of the Church, we commemorate the birth of St. John, whose birth was foretold by an Angel and who was born 6 months before our Lord. He was the son of Zechariah and Elizabeth, a cousin



of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He is considered the greatest and last prophet of the Old Testament. His purpose was to prepare the way and announce the coming of the long expected Messiah, the Redeemer. While the feast of other Saints is celebrated on the day of their death, the day of their final victory, St. John the Baptist's feast day is his birthday, as he was born free from original sin.

# OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP

Our Lady of Perpetual Help is a Help is a Roman Catholic title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary by Pope Pius IX. It is associated with the highly esteemed 15<sup>th</sup> century Byzantine image on display

in the Church of St Alfonso di Liguori, Rome. Due to the promotion by the <u>Redemptorist</u> Priests since 1865, the image has become very popular among Roman Catholics.

The image depicts the following symbols:

The Blessed Virgin Mary — wearing a dress of dark red, in Byzantine iconography the color of an empress, or Queen. It shows Mary looking towards the faithful, while pointing at her son, Jesus Christ who is frightened by the instruments of crucifixion and is depicted with a fallen sandal. On the left side is Saint Michael Archangel carrying the lance and sponge of the crucifixion of Jesus. On the right side is Saint Gabriel Archangel carrying a 3-bar cross and nails. The Virgin Mary has a star on her forehead signifying her role as Star of the Sea while the cross on the side has been claimed as referring to the Greek monastery which produced the icon.
