### SAINT ROSE OF LIMA

Patroness of South America

Isabel de Flores y del Olivia, called Rose by her mother because of her red cheeks, was born in Lima Peru in the year of 1586 of Spanish parentage. She worked long and hard to help support her family, growing flowers and doing embroidery and other needlework. Having taken a vow of virginity early in life, she refused to

marry and became a Dominican Tertiary at the age of twenty. She occupied a summerhouse in the garden of her parents, where she lived a life of prayer and penance. St. Rose cared for the sick and suffering among the poor, Indians and slaves. She is regarded the originator of social service in Peru. She died 1617 and was canonized 1671 and so became the first Saint of the New World.

### SAINT BARTHOLOMEW

Apostle

In the Gospels of Mark and Luke, Saint Bartholomew is one of the twelve Apostles, found by Philip and chosen by Jesus himself. In John's Gospel Bartholomew, which means "son of Tolmai" is not mentioned, but does list a Nathanael in his account of the gathering of Apostles. It is reasonably, but not conclusively, that the two names designate the same person. Legend tells us, that St. Bartholomew was preaching in India, Armenia, Mesopotamia and



Persia. This Saint surly suffered Martyrdom, but of what kind is not known for sure, some say he was flayed alive and beheaded, in other accounts he suffered crucifixion. His relics are preserved in the church of St. Bartholomew on the island in the river Tiber near Rome.

Lord, strengthen in us that faith by which Your Apostle St. Bartholomew adhered to Your Son with sincerity of mind. Through his intercession, grant that Your Church may become a sacrament of salvation for all nations. Amen.

# ST. MONICA Patroness of mothers

What we know about St. Monica comes from St. Augustine's Confessions. Monica was born in North Africa about the year 332. Even so her parents were Christians she was given in marriage to Patricius, a pagan citizen of Tagaste.

Patricius was a man with a good heart but had a violent temper and bad habits. Monica bore all trials with great patience. Her example had such great influence over her husband that he and his mother converted to Christianity. Patricius died a year after his baptism.

The great cross of her life was the conduct her son Augustine, who was 17 years old when his father died. St. Monica constantly prayed for his conversion and in August 386 she saw her son return to God. At Easter 387 he was baptized by St. Ambrose. Monica's work was done; her son was converted; the sinner became a saint. St. Monica enjoyed a close relationship with her son from then on. She died in 387.

God, comforter of the afflicted, You accepted St. Monica's tears to bring about the conversion of her son St. Augustine. Through their intersession, grant that we may have contrition for our sins and experience the grace of your pardon. Amen.

### ST. AUGUSTINE Patron of Theologians

St. Augustine was born November 13, 354. In spite of the piety of his mother, St. Monica, he fell at an early into the greatest disorders. He had a mistress and they had a son. According to Roman law they could not



marry because they belonged to different social classes. After his baptism (see St. Monica) and after the death of his mother St. Monica and the death of his son, who died in 389, he established a religious community. In the year 391, people of Hippo, insisted that Augustine be ordained. As priest he preached with enormous success. 396 he became Bishop of Hippo. He was kind and charitable. He became a strong defender of the Faith. In his humility he wrote his Confessions about the year 397, and from this work we have a detailed account of his early years. This multifaceted religious genius and devout servant of God died August 28th, 430.

Lord, renew in Your Church the spirit which You inspired in Augustine, Your Bishop. Filled by this spirit, may we thirst after You as the true Source of wisdom. Amen.

### THE BEHEADING OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST

St. John the Baptist was chosen by God to be the "Forerunner of the Messiah". His mother was the cousin of Mary, the Mother of Jesus.



After reaching manhood St. John led a penitential and holy life for many years in the desert. It was he who pointed out Jesus to the people by the Sea of Galilee and baptized Jesus. It was he who told Herod that by taking his brother's wife Herodias, he defied divine and human laws. For this reproof Herod imprisoned St. John. About a year later Herod celebrated his birthday at which Herodias' daughter Salome danced. Her dance pleased Herod and he swore to give her anything she wanted. At the advice of her daughter Salome asked for the head of St. John the Baptist on a platter. Having made the oath, even so it was a sinful one. Herod ordered to have St. John beheaded. Jesus called St. John, His Forerunner, the greatest among those born of women

God our Father, You called John the Baptist to be the herald of Your Son's birth and death. As he gave his life in witness to truth and justice, so may we strive to profess our faith in You. Amen.
