# **SAINT MATTHEW**

# SAINT PADRE PIO

Francesco Forgione was born of simple, hardworking farming people on May 25<sup>th</sup>, 1887 in Pietrelcina, Southern Italy. He was tutored privately until his entry into the Capuchin Friars at the age of 15,

taking the name Pio ("pious"). Of feeble health but strong will, with the help of grace he completed the required studies and was ordained a priest in 1910. On September 20<sup>th</sup>, 1918 the five wounds of our Lord's Passion appeared on his body, making him the first stigmatized priest in the history of the Church. His whole life was marked by long hours of prayer. His letters to his spiritual directors reveal his very deep union with God, his burning love for the Blessed Eucharist and our Blessed Lady. Worn out by over half a century of intense suffering and constant apostolic activity in San Giovanni Rotondo, he was called to his heavenly reward on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1968 and was canonized in 2002.

All-powerful God, You blessed Saint Pio by allowing him to participate in Your sufferings. Help us, through his prayers, that we too accept all our suffering with patience and love for You. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.
