**SAINT MATTHEW**

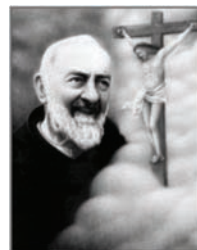
Apostle, Evangelist.



St. Matthew, one of the twelve Apostles, is the author of the first Gospel. Before his conversion St. Matthew was a tax collector by profession. He was called by Jesus to be an Apostle while sitting in the tax collector's place at Capernaun. It is commonly held his name was Levi until Jesus called him Matthew, which means "Gift of God". St. Matthew composed his Gospel in his native Aramaic, the "Hebrew tongue". His Gospel appeared between 42 A.D. and 50 A.D. and shows Jesus as the fulfillment of God's promise of a Messiah.

*God of mercy, You chose a tax collector, Saint Matthew, to share the dignity of the apostles. By following his example and benefiting by his prayers, may we always follow Christ and abide by Your will. Amen.*

**SAINT PADRE PIO**

Francesco Forgione was born of simple, hardworking farming people on May 25<sup>th</sup>, 1887 in Pietrelcina, Southern Italy. He was tutored privately until his entry into the Capuchin Friars at the age of 15, taking the name Pio ("pious"). Of feeble health but strong will, with the help of grace he completed the required studies and was ordained a priest in 1910. On September 20<sup>th</sup>, 1918 the five wounds of our Lord's Passion appeared on his body, making him the first stigmatized priest in the history of the Church. His whole life was marked by long hours of prayer. His letters to his spiritual directors reveal his very deep union with God, his burning love for the Blessed Eucharist and our Blessed Lady. Worn out by over half a century of intense suffering and constant apostolic activity in San Giovanni Rotondo, he was called to his heavenly reward on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1968 and was canonized in 2002.

*All-powerful God, You blessed Saint Pio by allowing him to participate in Your sufferings. Help us, through his prayers, that we too accept all our suffering with patience and love for You. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.*

**OUR LADY OF RANSOM**

Between the eighth and the fifteenth centuries, intermittently war between the Christian kingdoms of southern Europe and the Muslim states of North Africa, was raging Raids by militias, bands and armies from both sides were an almost annual occurrence. Capture, whether by pirates or



raiders, was a continuous threat to residents of coastal areas on both sides of the conflict. Tradition holds that in 11218 Peter Nolasco was inspired by a vision of the Virgin Mary, who asked him to establish a religious order dedicated to rescue the many Christian captives held by the Muslims. The religious order of the Mercedarians, Originally its membership held more knights than clerics. The knights guarded the coasts, and undertook the dangerous task of ransoming Christian captives, while the clerics were charged with the celebration of the Divine Office Mercedarians believe that the Virgin Mary was the true founder and patroness of their order.

*O God, who by means of the most glorious Mother of Your Son was pleased to give new children to Your Church for the deliverance of Christ's faithful from the power of the heathen; grant, we beseech You, that we who love and honour her as the foundress of so great a work may we by her merits and intercession, be delivered from all sin and from the bondage of the evil one. Jesuit priest Isaac Jogues and laymen Rene Goupil and Jean de la Lande met their death in the United

States. Jean Brebeuf, Antoine Daniel, Gabriel Lalemant, Charles Garnier and Noel Chabanel, were all Jesuit priests and met their gruesome martyrdom in Canada. The 8 Saints came from Europe in response to a call for missionaries to the Indians. Fully aware of the dangers involved, they persisted in their efforts to preach the Gospel to the aboriginal people. They all endured much hardship in life and showed great courage facing death
