DEDICATION OF ST. JOHN LATERAN

Chair of the Bishop of Rome (Pope)



The Archcathedral St. John Lateran was originally the palace of Emperor Constantine, adapted to serve as the church of the Pope. The property was owned by the Laterani family. The original church was dedicated under the title "Our Saviour". The present Archbasilica was built later, on the site of the original church and was dedicated to St. John the Baptist but is known as St. John Lateran and ranks first among the four greater patriarchal churches of Rome. The other patriarchal basilicas are St. Peter's, St. Mary Major and St. Paul's.

God our Father, from living stones, Your chosen people, You built an eternal temple to Your glory. Increase the spiritual gifts You have given to Your Church, so that Your faithful people may continue to grow into the new and eternal Jerusalem. Amen.

SAINT LEO THE GREAT

Doctor of the Church



St. Leo was born in Tuscany. As deacon he was dispatched by Emperor Valentinian III. as mediator to bring peace to warring Roman factions which were leaving Gaul vulnerable. He is well known for his peacekeeping efforts. 440 he became Pop and reigned as such till his death in 461. He persuaded the Emperor to recognize the primacy of the Bishop of Rome in an edict in 445. Saint Leo is best known for his pastoral sermons on faith and charity. His teachings have had a lasting influence in the Catholic Church. He is the first Pope, whose sermons and letters have been preserved. They are of great historical value. 1754 he was made Doctor of the Church.

God our Father, you will never allow the power of hell to prevail against your Church, founded on the rock of the apostle Peter. Let the prayers of Pope Leo the Great keep us faithful to your truth and secure in your peace. Amen.

ST. MARTIN OF TOURS

Patron of Soldiers



Saint Martin was born in Hungary about 317. The son of pagan parents, early in life he became a catechumen. Like his father he served in the Roman army until, after he had given half his cloak to a beggar at Amiens, a vision of Christ (about 339) impelled him to Baptism and the religious life. He was ordained and had the happiness of converting his mother. He was chosen Bishop of Tours in 371. St. Martin, as well as St. Ambrose, energetically protested against those who would put heretics to death. This great saint converted pagans to the faith. His virtues of were rewarded by an extraordinary gift of miracles. He died peacefully in the year 397.

Father, Your Bishop St. Martin glorified You by both his life and his death. Renew in us Your grace, so that neither death nor life may separate us from Your love. Amen.

**ST. FRANCES XAVIER CABRINI**

Patroness of Immigrants



Francesca Xavier Cabrini was born 1850, in northern Italy. She took her being named after St. Francis Xavier seriously. It was her desire to become a religious and in particular a missionary even so she was physically small and frail in health. At 18 she applied to join 2 religious Orders, but was rejected by both. A priest asked her to teach in a school for girls. She did so for 6 years. At the request of her Bishop she founded an Order for women missionaries the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart. Soon women joined her and they looked after poor children in schools and hospitals. At the urging of Pope Leo XIII Frances Xavier Cabrini and 6 sisters set sail for America to work among Italian Immigrants. Filled with a deep trust in God, who endowed her with administrative ability she soon founded schools, hospitals and orphanages to aid Italian immigrants and their children. She established sixty-seven houses including orphanages, hospitals and schools in US Cities.. Her institute numbers houses in England, France, Spain, Central and South America St. Frances Xavier trusted blindly in the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and that trust was not misplaced. She died December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1917 in Chicago. Her remains are venerated in the chapel of the High School named after her in New York City. Pope Pius XII canonized this humble, holy woman on July 7, 1946.

God, through the work of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini You brought comfort and love to the immigrants and those in need. May her example and work continued in those dedicated to You. Amen.
