SAINTS NEREUS, ACHILLEUS AND PANCRAS Martyrs



According to Pope St. Damasus, STS. NEREUS AND ACHILLEUS were Roman soldiers of the 1st century. They became Christians and as such refused to remain in the service. They were martyred for their Faith. A bas-relief of Achilles being stricken is the oldest known representation of martyrdom.

ST. PANCRAS was of noble birth and was baptized at the age of fourteen. Trying to live a true Christian life, he gave all his possessions to the poor, which drew the attention of the authorities to him being a Christian. When he refused to renounce his Christianity, he was decapitated about the year 304.

OUR LADY OF FATIMA

This title was given to the Blessed Virgin Mary after she appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, between May 13 and October 13, 1917, the three messages or "secrets" of Fatima stress the importance of repentance, conversion of heart, find dedication to Our Lady, especially through daily prayer of the Rosary.

SAINT MATTHIAS Apostle

From the Acts of the Apostles we learn that St. Matthias had been on of the companions of Jesus, our Saviour, from the day of His baptism by St. John; for when the Apostles had to choose an Apostle to take the place of Judas. Saint Peter spoke: "Of these men who have been in our company all the time that the Lord Jesus moved among us, from John's baptism until the day that He was taken up from us, of these one must become a witness with us of His Resurrection" (Acts 1,21) Two men were proposed; Barsabbas and Matthias and Matthias, who was one of the seventy-two

disciples of our Lord, was chosen by lot. At this election about 120 followers of Christ were present. It was after St. Matthias became one of the Apostles the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles. Some legends state that he was crucified, but tradition that became incorporated in his emblem is that he was beheaded; this shows an axe superimposed over an open book in which the words "upon Matthias" are written. His relics were taken to Jerusalem and at least some of them were sent to Rome by the empress St. Helena.

Lord God, You chose St. Matthias to be an Apostle replacing Judas. Through his intervention may we enjoy the reward of Your love and be numbered among the elect. Amen.

The Teaching of Christ

We salute Christ among us. He is the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity, true God and true man. Christ came to guarantee our salvation. He came to save us by His suffering and death. But more important, He came to teach us to live so as to gain the promised reward for which God the Father created us. Christ teaches us by miracles, by demonstrating His love and concern for us, by assuring us of salvation if we follow Him and obey God, our loving Father. His Apostle, John, tells us that Jesus said: "I am the light of the world, no follower of mine shall ever walk in darkness, no, he shall possess the light of life." And Christ also tells us that He and God the Father are the one true God: "The Father and I are one." It is Jesus who speaks in the name of the Father telling us how to come to the Father through our service and love of God and neighbor. And again and again Christ proves that He is the Light leading us to God. Jesus declared: "I have come to the world as its light, to keep everyone who believes in me from remaining in the dark." Knowing that Christ is ever before us, lighting our way and leading us, we can each hope to return to God the Creator of us all and find the bounty and blessedness of eternal glory with Him in heaven.

fullness of grace and every good.

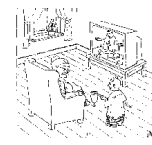
