OUR LADY, HELP OF CHRISTIANS

When Napoleon, who had conquered Papal States before his exil to Elba, left Elba and returned to Paris to reclaim his power, Murat, French Marchall and King of Naples, prepared

to march through the Papal States. Pope Puis VII fled to Savona, where on May 10, 1815 he crowned the image of Our Lady of Mercy. July 7, 1815, after the Congress of Vienna he returned to Rome. In gratidute he instituded the feast of "Our Lady, Help of Christians" to be celebrated in the Papal States.

In 1816 the Dioceses of Tuscany adopted the feast and from there it has spread throughout the Latin Church. When St. John Bosco, dedicated the Salesian Congregation in 1868, to Our Lady, Help of Christians, this Feast has attained great fame. ******************

ST. BEDE THE VENERABLE

Doctor of the Church

St. Bede was born in England about the year 673. At the age of 7 he was sent to a Benedict Monastary to be educated. Later he became a Benedict Monk. St. Bede was a most learned



man of his time and a gifted writer. He wrote many historical works and beautiful biographies about the lives of Anglo-Saxon

Saints. Up to the hour of his death on Ascencion Day 735 this Saint was engaged in translating the Gospel of St. John from the Greek. While singing "Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Ghost" - just as he said "Holy Ghost" his soul went forth to meet his Triune God.

All-powerful God, You blessed Saint Bede by giving him the gift of writing. Help us, through his prayers that we may recognize the gifts you have given us and help us to put them to use in your service. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.

ST. PHILIP NERI

St. Philip Neri, was born in Florence, Italy in the yaer 1515. As child he was already known as "Pippo Buono" (good little Philip) At the age of 18 he was sent to a childless, wealthy relative to become the heir. But God had other



plans for him. Guided by the Holy Spirit he soon left for Rome without money or specific plans. When in Rome, he lived in a unfurnished room spending long hours in prayer. Soon he started his "street-corner" apostolate. He encouraged passer- bys to" begin to do good" by caring for the sick, aiding the poor and enlightening the uninstructed. Directed by his confessor Philip studied for the priesthood and was ordained May 23, 1551. He laboured unceasingly for the salvation of souls and was so successful, that he was called "Apostle of Rome". St. Philip Neri enjoyed many mystical experiences. God granted him the gifts of prophecy and insight into souls. He celebrated the Holy Eucharist and heard confessions up to the last full day of his life. He died early in the morning May 26, 1595, beloved by all in Rome, where the people acclaimed him immediately a Saint. He was beatified 6 years after his death and canonized in 1623.

Let us follow St. Philip Neri's motto: If you want to be obeyed, don't make commandments. - It is easier to guide cheerful people in their spiritual life than melancholy ones. - Be good if you can.
