Prayer for Fathers



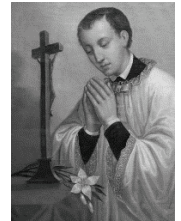

SAINT ALOYSIUS GONZAGA

Patron of Catholic Youth



St. Aloysius, son of Ferdinand, Marquis of Castiglione (Italy) was connected with all the royal houses. From a very young age St. Aloysius devoted himself heart and soul to the service of his creator. At fourteen years of age he accompanied his father to Spain, where he was made page to Prince James by Philip II. His innocence remained uncontaminated amid the vanities of the court, nor could the world draw his heart from God. In the year 1585, in spite of great opposition, he gave up his rights as eldest son and joined the Jesuits in Rome. From the beginning of his religious life St. Aloysius was a model of perfection. He hoped to go to the missions, but when the plague broke out in 1591, he distinguished himself by his charity toward the sick and dying in the hospital. He caught the plague himself and died on June 21st, 1591 at the age of 23, but his zeal for God, both as young man and as a prince remained an inspiration and example for all. St. Aloysius was canonized in 1726.

Father of love, giver of all good things, in Saint Aloysius you combined remarkable innocence with the spirit of penance. By the help of his prayers may we who have not followed his innocence follow his example of penance. Amen.

STS JOHN FISHER AND THOMAS MORE

ST. JOHN FISHER was born in Beverly, Yorkshire in 1459. His studies at Cambridge were so excellent, that he was ordained by special permission when he was just 22 years old. In 1504 he was made Bishop of Rochester and Chancellor of Cambridge, in which capacity he also tutored Prince Henry, who was to become King Henry VIII. St. John was a humble servant dedicated to the welfare of his diocese and his

TWELFTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

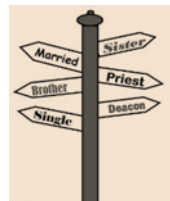

university. St. John, Erasmus and Thomas More became great friends, actively opposing the King's divorce from Catherine of Aragon, he was imprisoned in the Tower of London in April 1534. 1535 he was made Cardinal by Pope Paul III. King Henry retaliated by having him beheaded within a month.



ST. THOMAS MORE was born in London in 1478. After thorough grounding in religion and the classics, he entered Oxford to study law, was called to the bar in 1501 and 3 years later he entered Parliament. In 1505 he married Jane Colt who bore him four children. An enlightened man, he insisted that his 3 daughters receive the same education as his son. After

Jane's death Thomas married a widow, Alice Middleton to be a mother to his young children. This learned man attracted the attention of King Henry the VIII, who appointed him to many high posts and made him Lord Chancellor in 1529, however he resigned in 1532, when Henry persisted in holding his own opinions regarding marriage and the supremacy of the Pope. In 1534, with his close friend John Fisher, he refused to render alliance to the King as Head of the Church and was confined to the Tower of London. Fifteen days after the execution of John Fisher he was convicted of treason and was beheaded on July 6, 1535. St. Thomas More is Patron of Lawyers.

God, You consummated the form of the true Faith in martyrdom. Through the intercession of Sts. John and Thomas, grant that we may confirm by the testimony of our lives that Faith which we profess with our tongues. Amen.

BIRTH OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST



On this feast day, one of the oldest in the liturgy of the Church, we commemorate the birth of St. John, whose birth was foretold by an Angel and who was born 6 months before our Lord. He was the son of Zechariah and Elizabeth, a cousin of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He is considered the greatest and last prophet of the Old Testament. His purpose was to prepare the way and announce the coming of the long expected Messiah, the Redeemer. While the feast of other Saints is celebrated on the day of their death, the day of their final victory; St. John the Baptist's feast day is his birthday, as he was born free from original sin.

God, our Father, You raised up John the Baptist to prepare a perfect people for Christ the Lord. Give Your Church joy in spirit and guide those who believe in You into the way of salvation and peace. Amen.
