

SAINT PETER AND SAINT PAUL

Apostles



SAINT PETER was a married fisherman in Galilee when chosen by Jesus to be his disciple. His name was Simon till he confessed that Jesus was the Christ and Jesus changed his name to Peter (Petros) and told him that it was on this rock (petra) that he would build his Church. After the Ascension, Acts record that Peter was indeed the "chief of the Apostles" and

documents show that the Bishops of Rome were recognized as successors of Peter. In the year 67, the last year of Nero's reign Saint Peter was crucified, at his own request, with his head downward because he did not deem himself worthy to die as did his Divine Master.

SAINT PAUL was born in Tarsus, a Roman citizen raised and educated as a Pharisee. He was a zealous persecutor of Christians till his experience of the risen Christ resulted in his conversion. Paul became an Apostle. He called himself the "Apostle of the Gentiles". Saint Paul was beheaded in the year 67.



God our Father, today You give us the joy of celebrating the feast of the apostles Peter and Paul. Through them Your Church first received the faith. Keep us true to their teaching. Amen.

FIRST MARTYRS OF THE CHURCH OF ROME

This day is dedicated to honour the first martyrs of the Church of Rome who were put to death at the Vatican Circus at the time of persecution under the Emperor Nero in the year 64. Countless Christians met their death in various unspeakable ways 3 years before Saints Peter & Paul were put to death.

July 3rd SAINT THOMAS Apostle, Martyr, Patron Saint of builders and of India and Pakistan

St. Thomas was one of the chosen Twelve. His name occurs in all Gospels. St. Thomas was present at the raising of Lazarus. He was with Jesus at the last Supper. He earned the phrase "Doubting

Thomas" when he did not believe the Apostles that Jesus was with them after His Resurrection and declared, that he would not believe if he could not put his finger in Jesus' Five Wounds. When Jesus appeared and invited St. Thomas to put his finger in His Wounds, St. Thomas' surrender was absolute and made the great confession "My Lord and my God". Thomas the doubter became St. Thomas the believer. St. Thomas went forth to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the Parthians, Medes, and Persians. He then entered India where he instructed People in the Christian Faith and performed many miracles. St. Thomas was condemned to death and was pierced with arrows.

Almighty Father, as we honour Thomas the apostle, let us always experience the help of his prayers. May we have eternal life by believing in Jesus, whom Thomas acknowledged as Lord. Amen.
