### SAINT MARIA GORETTI

Our Patron Saint and Patroness of Youth.

Saint Maria Goretti was born October 16th. 1890 in Corinaldo, Italy. Maria was the third child of seven children to bless the union of Luigi and Assunta Goretti.



When Maria was 5 years old the Goretti family moved to Ferriere Less than two years later Luigi died and Assunta was forced to work on the farm to earn a living, 9-year-old Maria assumed complete care of her six siblings and had to cooked for the Serenellis. Maria was deeply religious. Maria begged her mother to let her take instructions for First Holy Communion, before the customary age of 12. On the feast of Corpus Christi she received Jesus for the first time in Holy Communion.

Being a beautiful girl, she attracted the attentions of 20year-old Alessandro. On a number of occasions he asked Maria to sin with him, Maria denied him, but did not tell her mother for fear Alessandro would do harm to her family. July 5<sup>th</sup>, 1902 he was denied no longer. When Maria resisted him with all her strength, crying out: "It is a sin God does not want it", he drew a knife and struck her 14 times with it. After 20 hours of suffering during which she received Holy Communion for the last time and forgave her murderer. Maria died July 6<sup>th</sup>. On June 24<sup>th</sup>, 1950 Maria Goretti was canonized.

After serving eight years of unrepentant imprisonment, Alessandro had a complete change of heart. Maria's prayers were answered! Released for good behavior after twenty-seven years, he hastened to beg forgiveness of Maria's mother and became a Capuchin lay brother. Alessandro gave evidence at the canonical enquiry and lived to see his victim canonized.

God, author of innocence and lover of chastity. You conferred on St. Maria Goretti, Your handmaid, the grace of martyrdom at a youthful age. Through her intercession grant us constancy in Your commandments, You who gave the crown to a virgin who fought for You. Amen.

# SAINT AUGUSTINE ZHAO RONG AND **COMPANIONS**

In the 19<sup>th</sup> century Christians were persecuted in China. Imperial edicts imposed the death penalty

on all who attempted to evangelize or educate and ordinate priests. Augustine Zhao Rong was a soldier. While he was escorting a missionary priest from France he was converted and baptized. He then studied at a seminary and was ordained. In 1815 he and 119 companions, after refusing an offer of clemency if they abandon their Christian Faith, were tortured and martyred. Pope John Paul II canonized them in the year 2000.

Almighty God, through the intersession of St. Augustine Zhao Rong and his companions, give us too the strength and courage to stand by our Faith in word and deed. Amen. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*

### **OUR LADY QUEEN OF PEACE**

Tradition holds that in 1682 some merchants found an abandoned box on the shore of Salvador's Mar del Sur. Unable to open it, they tied the box on a donkey's back and set out to inform the local authorities of their find. When they were passing the parish church, now a cathedral, the donkey lay down on the ground. They were then able to open



the box and were surprised to find that it contained an image of Our Lady holding the Child. It is said that a bloody struggle was going on between the inhabitants of the region, but when they heard of the marvelous discovery in the abandoned box, they put down their weapons and immediately ceased fighting. This is why the image was given the title of Our Lady of Peace. Also when the Chaparrastique volcano erupted and threatened to destroy the city with burning lava. The frightened dwellers of San Miguel brought out the statute of Our Lady of Peace to the principal door of the cathedral, and at that precise moment the force of the lava changed direction, moving away from the city.

Pope Benedict XV authorized the canonical coronation of the image which took place on November 21, 1921.

Her official memorial in the General Roman Calendar is on July 9 in the universal Church
