FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today we will hear again the great parable of the Good Samaritan. In this parable Jesus tells us that God wants us to care for one another. Sins of omission may be our worst sins, yet we don't always think of them as sins. Jesus is the Good Samaritan. He binds up our wounds.

ST. HENRY II

St. Henry was born in 972 to Henry the Duke of Bavaria and Gisella, daughter of the King of Burgundy. Young Henry was educated under the care of St. Wolfgang. In 995 St. Henry succeeded



his father as Duke of Bavaria and in 1002 he was elected Emperor. As Emperor he sought the greater glory of God and was watchful over the welfare of the church. In 1014 he received at the hands of Pope Benedict VIII the imperial crown. Several times circumstances drove the holy Emperor into war. The humility and spirit of Justice of the Saint were equal to his zeal for religion. Both he and his wife, St Cunegundes lived in perpetual chastity, to which both of them bound themselves by vow. St. Henry gave liberally to pious institutions and build the cathedral of Bamberg. He died at the castle of Grone in 1024. He was canonized by Pope Eugene III in 1146.



July 14th

BLESSED KATERI TEKAWITHA

Kateri was born near the town of Auriesville, New York, in the year 1656. She was the daughter of a Mohawk warrior. Kateri was 4 years old when her mother died of small-box. The disease also attacked Kateri and

transfigured her face. She was adopted by her two aunts and an uncle.

Kateri became converted as teenager and was baptized at the age of twenty. She incurred the great hostility of her tribe. She suffered greatly for her Faith, but remained firm in it. Kateri went to the new Christian colony of Indians in Canada. Here she lived a life dedicated to prayer and the care of the aged and sick. She was devoted to the Eucharist and to Jesus Crucified. She died April 7th, 1680 at the age of 24. Kateri is known as the "Lily of the Mohawks".

Lord, You called the Virgin, Blessed Kateri, to shine forth among the Indian people as an example of purity of life. Grant, through her intercession, that all people of every nation, tribe and tongue, may be gathered into Your Church and proclaim Your greatness in one song of praise. Amen.



July 15th

ST. BONAVENTURE

Patron of one of our Elementary Schools

St. Bonaventure, known as the "Angelic Doctor" was born 1221 in Tuscany, of pious parents. He

was baptized Giovanni (John) after his father. Legend has it that he received the name Bonaventure (Good Fortune) in consequence of an exclamation by St. Francis of Assisi who cured him miraculously of a dangerous illness and foreseeing the future greatness of little Giovanni cried out "O buona ventura".

At age 21 St. Bonaventure entered the Franciscan Order and had such great influence, that he has been called its second founder. He was sent to Paris to complete his studies where he received the degree of Doctor of Theology together St. Thomas Aquinas who was his friend.

At age 35 St. Bonaventure was chosen minister general of his Order. He composed the Life of St. Francis. He became Cardinal and Bishop of Albano, one of the six suffragan Sees of Rome. He died while he was assisting Pope Gregory X at the fourteenth ecumenical council of Lyons, called to bring about the reunion of the Greek and Latin rites and the liberation of the Holy Land. He was canonized in 1482 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1588.

July 16th

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

This is the patronal feast of the Carmelites. Mount Carmel was the first place dedicated to the Blessed Virgin and where a chapel was erected in her honour before her Assumption into heaven. The Order of Carmelites takes its name from Mount Carmel and dates back to a group of Western hermits who in the 12th

century settled on Mount Carmel, overlooking the plain of Galilee, in imitation of the prophet Elijah they grouped themselves around that small chapel. In the 13th century, the Order of Carmel as we know it was formed.

Lord, let the motherly prayer of the glorious Virgin Mary come to our help. Through her support help us to reach the true mount which is Christ. Amen.
