ST. LAWRENCE OF BRINDISI Priest and Doctor of the Church

St. Lawrence was born Giolio Cesare Russo in Brindisi in the Kingdom of Naples, Italy July 22, 1559 to a family of Venetian merchants. At the age of 16 he entered the Capuchin

Franciscan Community at Verona and took the name "Lawrence". At the University of Padua. He studied philosophy and theology and excelled in languages. He spoke most European and Semitic languages fluently. After his ordination he labored a domestic missionary. Pope Clement VIII assigned him the task of converting Jews. 1598 he was sent with 11 other Capuchins to establish Capuchin communities throughout Germany and Austria to further the Counter Reformation and bring Lutherans back to the Catholic faith .In 1601 he served as imperial chaplain for the army of the Holy Roman Empire and organized catholic princes to help fight against the invading Ottoman Empire. He led the low spirited solders armed with only a crucifix held high and so defeated the Turks.

St. Lawrence, even holding many positions of importance, he was foremost a person of prayer and deep learning. This saint died on his birthday in 1619, was beatified on December 8, 1783 by Pope Pius VI. In 1881 he was canonized by Pope Leo XIII and in 1960 Pope John the XXIII declared him a Doctor of the Church.

God, for the glory of Your name and the salvation of souls, you favoured St. Lawrence, Your Priest with the spirit of wisdom and fortitude. Grant that in the same spirit we may recognize our obligations and with his help carry them out. Amen.

SAINT MARY MAGDALENE

Disciple of the Lord. Patroness of Dominicans

Saint Mary Magdalene is linked to



the unnamed sinner in Luke's gospel, who anointed the Lord's feet and received forgiveness of her sins because of her great love. and silver and gave the pieces to the poor. For this reason her father had her scourged with rods and then cast into a dungeon. This happened at a time when Emperor Diocletian persecuted Christians. In the dungeon she suffered many torments and a cruel death for her Faith. St. Christina's faith remained unshaken during all the torments she endured. Her relics are preserved at Palermo, Sicily.

All-powerful and ever-living God, You choose the weak in this world to put the powerful to shame. As we commemorate the martyrdom of St. Christine, help us to, like her, remain constant in faith. Amen.
