TWENTY FORTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

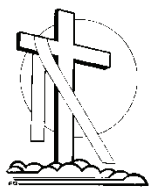
To sin is to stray from God. Which of us can say that we have never strayed from God? But Jesus the Good Shepherd comes looking for us and is overjoyed when he finds us.

September 14th TRIUMPH OF THE HOLY CROSS

When the Sacred Body of Jesus was taken down from the Cross and carried to his grave, the Cross, on which He had died was thrown into a ditch or well and covered over with stones and earth, so the followers of Jesus might not find it. In 312 A.D., Constantine the Great, not yet a Christian, battling with Maxentius for the throne of the Roman Empire, prayed to the God of the Christians, to help him. In answer to his prayer, a luminous cross or monogram of Christ appeared in the heavens with the inscription:” In this sign You will conquer.” He was victorious, and in gratitude the sign of Christianity was placed on all shields of his soldiers.

The finding of the True Cross came in 326 A.D. at Jerusalem by St. Helena, his mother. In the year 614, Chosroes II, King of Persia invaded Syria and Palestine; he took and sacked Jerusalem, carrying off with other treasures, the great relic of the True Cross. The Emperor Heraclius of Constantinople, at the head of a large army invaded Persia . After forcing the Persians to peace he piously brought the Sacred Cross back to Jerusalem in 629. When he reached the city gate he laid aside every mark of royalty, and clothed in sackcloth of penance and barefoot, carried the Cross up the ascent of Calvary and restored it in its place in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You, because by Your Holy Cross You have redeemed the world. Amen.

OUR LADY OF SORROWS (Formerly known as the “Seven Sorrows of Mary”)

The object of this feast is to remind us of the spiritual martyrdom of the Mother of God, and her compassion with the sufferings of her Divine Son. The seven great events of sorrow in her life were: The Prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the three days’ loss of Jesus, the meeting of her son on the Way to Calvary, Mary at the foot of the Cross, the body of Jesus resting in her arms, and the Burial of Jesus. There never could be a love greater between a human soul and God than the love between Jesus and Mary, since Mary loved Jesus not just as her son, but also loved Him as her God.



God, You willed that the compassionate Mother of Your Son should stand near the Cross on which He was glorified. Grant that Your Church, having shared in Christ’s Passion, may also participate in His Resurrection. Amen.

As this is the year of St. Joseph; let us turn to him in prayer.

Oh St. Joseph, do assist me by your powerful intercession and obtain for me from your divine son all spiritual blessings through Jesus Christ, our Lord; so that having engaged here below your heavenly power, I may offer my thanksgiving and homage to the most loving of Fathers.

Oh St. Joseph, I never weary contemplating you and Jesus asleep in your arms. I dare not approach while he reposes near your heart. Press Him in my name and kiss his fine head for me, and ask him to return the kiss when I draw my dying breath. St. Joseph, patron of departing souls, pray for us. Amen
