September 20th ST. ANDREW KIM TAEGON, PAUL **CHONG HASANG AND COMPANIONS** Martyrs,

The evangelization of Korea began through a group of lay people during the 17th century. A strong vital Christian community flourished under their leadership. In 1791 several Korean Catholics died for their faith. In 1794 a Chinese priest finally arrived. He was martyred with about 300 Catholics in 1801. 1837 Pope Pius VII entrusted the Paris Foreign Mission with sending missionaries to Korea. Bishop Imbert and two French priests and many lay Catholics were beheaded after being subjected to the most cruel tortures. During the 1900-century about 10,000 Christians were killed for their faith. 1886 France signed a treaty with Korea and the persecutions stopped, till a new wave of persecutions started in 1901 that saw over 700 Catholics killed. During the Korean war of 1950-53 many priests, nuns and lay people were killed or expelled. In today's still divided Korea the Church flourishes in the South, but remains underground in the North. Canonized were 103, made up of 3 bishops, 8 priests and the rest lay people, described as married and unmarried, old, young and children.

O God. You have created all nations and You are their salvation. In Korea You called a people of adoption to the Catholic Faith and nurtured their growth by the blood of Andrew, Paul, and their Companions. Grant us strength through their martyrdom and their intercession so that we too may remain faithful to Your commandments even until our death. Amen.

SAINT MATTHEW Apostle, Evangelist.



St. Matthew, one of the twelve Apostles, is the author of the first Gospel. Before his conversion

St. Matthew was a tax collector by profession. He was called by Jesus to be an Apostle while sitting in the tax collector's place at Capernaun. It is commonly held his name was Levi until Jesus called him Matthew, which means "Gift of God". St. Matthew composed his Gospel in his native Aramaic, the "Hebrew tongue". His Gospel appeared between 42 A.D. and 50 A.D. and shows Jesus as the fulfillment of God's promise of a Messiah.

God of mercy, You chose a tax collector, Saint Matthew, to share the dignity of the apostles. **B**y following his example and benefiting by his prayers, may we always follow Christ and abide by Your will. Amen.



September 23rd SAINT PADRE PIO

Francesco Forgione was born of simple, hardworking farming people on May 25th, 1887 in Pietrelcina, Southern Italy. He was tutored privately

until his entry into the Capuchin Friars at the age of 15, taking the name Pio ("pious"). Of feeble health but strong will, with the help of grace he completed the required studies and was ordained a priest in 1910. On September 20th, 1918 the five wounds of our Lord's Passion appeared on his body, making him the first stigmatized priest in the history of the Church. His whole life was

marked by long hours of prayer. His letters to his spiritual directors reveal his very deep union with God, his burning love for the Blessed Eucharist and our Blessed Lady. Worn out by over half a century of intense suffering and constant apostolic activity he was called to his heavenly reward on September 23rd, 1968 and was canonized in 2002.

All-powerful God, You blessed Saint Pio by allowing him to participate in Your sufferings. Help us, through his prayers, that we too accept all our suffering with patience and love for You. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.
