1600.In 1605 on a voyage by sea he fell into the hands of pirates and was taken as slave to Tunis, where he was for two years before he could escape. After being in Rome he returned to France, where he became a preacher, but charity became his predominant virtue. St. Vincent de Paul died at the age of 80 in the year 1660.


