October 11th POPE SAINT JOHN XXIII

Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was the fourth child of fourteen children born to a family of sharecroppers who lived in a small village in Lombardy, region of Italy on November 25th,

1881.He received First Holy Communion and Confirmation at the age of 8. At the age of 15 he was enrolled by the director of the seminary into the Secular Franciscan Order and professed his vows on 23rd of May 1897. August 10th 1904, after completing his doctorate he was ordained priest. He was assigned to many posts in several countries. 1953 Pope Pius XII made Roncalli a Cardinal. On October 28th, 1958, after the death of Pius XII he began his Papacy. He chose the name John and became John XXIII. He is best known for opening the historic Second Vatican Council with the first session opening on October 11th, 1962. Sadly he did not live to see the Vatican Council to completion. He died of stomach cancer on June 3rd, 1963. Pope John the XXIIII is known as the "Good Pope". He was beatified September 3rd, 2000 and was canonized on April 27th, 2014. His Feast Day is celebrated October 11th, the anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council.

ST. TERESA OF AVILA

Virgin and Doctor of the Church

St. Teresa was born on March 28th, 1515 in Avila, Spain. Her father, Don Alfonso, was a man of solid piety, charitable to the poor, gentle



and considerate with his servants. Beatriz, her mother brought up her nine children in the fear and love of God and devout to Mary, the Mother of God and the Saints. When her mother died, she was only 14 years old; her father placed her in a convent of Augustinian nuns. After returning home for a short while she persuaded one of her brothers to become a Friar. Against their father's wishes they left early in the morning November 2, 1533 their father's house; Her brother for the Dominican Monastery and Teresa for the Carmelite Convent of the Incarnation in Avila, where she made her profession after many trials and sufferings. Teresa soon advanced in prayer, experiencing visions and hearing voices. She wrote many books on Mystical Theology. Teresa was canonized in 1622 and was added to the role of the Doctors of the Church on September 22, 1970 by Pope Paul VI.

Father, You raised up St. Teresa of Avila by Your Spirit so she could show Your Church the way to perfection. Nourish us with the food of heaven, and fire us with a desire for holiness. Amen.



October 19th NORTH AMERICAN MARTYRS

Jesuit priest Isaac Jogues and laymen Rene Goupil and Jean de la Lande met their death in the United States. Jean Brebeuf, Antoine

Daniel, Gabriel Lalemant, Charles Garnier and Noel Chabanel, were all Jesuit priests and met their gruesome martyrdom in Canada. The 8 Saints came from Europe in response to a call for missionaries to the Indians. Fully aware of the dangers involved, they persisted in their efforts to preach the Gospel to the aboriginal people. They all endured much hardship in life and showed great courage facing death

Father, You consecrated the first beginnings of the faith in North America by the preaching and martyrdom of Saint John and Saint Isaac and their companions. By the help of their prayers may the Christian faith continue to grow throughout the world. Amen.
