ST. DYMPHNA Patroness pf those suffering of nervous and mental afflictions

St. Dymphna was born in the 7<sup>th</sup> Century in Ireland/. Her father Damon, a pagan chieftain of great power and wealth. Her mother a devout Christin died when Dymphna was only 14 years old. Damon was mentally ill brought on by grief. He was looking for a wife of noble birth and resembling Dymphna's mother. When none was found he was advised by evil advisers to marry his own daughter. St. Dymphna fled with St. Gerebran, her confessor and two trusted servants, and the king's fool. Though it is uncertain what exactly happened next, the best-known version claims the group settled in Geel, where Dymphna built a hospital for the poor and sick, but in using her wealth, her father was able to discover their location.. He ordered the priest's head to be cut off. He tried to persuade his daughter to return to Ireland and marry him. When she refused he drew his sword and cut her head off. She was only 15years old. Dymphna received the crown of martyrdom around the year 620 as she defended of purity,

### SAINT RITA OF CASCIA

Widow, Patroness of Impossible Cases.



St. Rita was born at Spoleto, Italy in 1381. From an early age, Rita begged her parent to allow her to enter a convent, but her parents betrothed her to a

cruel man with a violent temper, whom she married at the age of 18. Rita became a good wife and mother of twin sons. She was often mistreated by her husband, who taught their children his own evil ways. Rita prayed for her family. After almost 20 years of marriage, her husband was stabbed and died, but not before he repented. Rita's prayers were heard. Her twin sons were determined to avenge their father's death an again Rite appealed to heaven to prevent such a crime. Her prayers were answered and her two sons died before committing a crime, reconciled to God. After the death of her sons, she was alone in this world, she filled her days with good works, prayer, fasting and penance till she, after being initially refused, was finally admitted to the Augustinian convent at Cascia, Umbria, where she lived for 40 years a life of perfect obedience and great charity. Having great devotion to the Passion of Christ, she asked to be allowed to suffer like Jesus. She was struck by one of the thorns from the crucifix on the forehead. This wound would not heal and did cause her much suffering till she died on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1457. After many miracles were attributed to her intercessions, she was canonized May 24th 1900.

God, through the prayers of St. Rita, may we learn to bear our crosses in life in the same spirit in which she bore hers. Amen.
