**ST. PAUL VI**  
Pope

Born Giovanni Battista Montini in 1897 in Italy. He was ordained in 1920 and spend years working in the Secretariat of State, In 1952 he was named Pro-Secretary of State. In 1953 Montini was appointed Archbishop of Milan. There he became known as the archbishop of the workers. In 1958 he was named Cardinal by Pope John XXIII. Pope John XXIII announced the Second Vatican Council, but died before its completion. Montini, who was well respected and on June 21 1963 was elected Pope, taking the name Paul VI. Pope Paul VI continuing the work John XXIII begun. He had to overcome resistance to implement reforms of liturgy, Church governance and attitudes towards other religions. Paul VI's papacy and writings aimed at working toward everlasting justice and peace. He promoted human rights, dignity and human development throughout the world. He believed that if you want peace you have to work for justice. Paul VI died August 6<sup>th</sup>, 1978, was beatified October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2014 and canonized October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018 by Pope Francis.

**VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

This feast commemorates the visit of the Blessed Virgin Mary to St. Elizabeth. At the time when Angel Gabriel told Mary, that she will conceive by the Holy Spirit, he also told her that her aged cousin, who was said to be barren, is expecting. Mary went to see Elizabeth and the two women, both with child, met. At this meeting the child in Elizabeth's womb, John the Baptist, leaped for joy. Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit recognized Mary as the Mother of God, and asked: "Why is it that the mother of my Lord comes to me." Part of St. Elizabeth's proclamation we use even today, whenever we pray the Hail Mary.

*Eternal Father, You inspired the Virgin Mary, mother of Your Son, to visit Elizabeth and assist her in her need. Keep us open to the working of Your Spirit, and with Mary may we praise You for ever. Amen.*

**SAINT ANGELA MERICI**

Patron of one of our Elementary Schools



Angela Merici was born in Desenzano, Lombardy, Italy on March 21<sup>st</sup>, 1474. At the age of eleven she was left orphaned. Together with her older sister she went to live with her uncle in Salo a nearby town. There she lived a very holy life, trying to please Jesus, the spouse of her soul. When her sister met with sudden death, without receiving the Last Sacraments, Angela was deeply distressed. She increased her prayers for the repose of her sister's soul. Imploring God to reveal to her the state of her sister, she was shown a vision that

her sister was with the Saints in Heaven. When Angela was twenty years of age her uncle died and she returned to her paternal home, which she converted into a school, where she instructed young girls in the Christian religion. In a vision it was revealed to her, that she should found an association of virgins to devote their lives to religious training of young girls. She accepted an invitation to establish a similar school in Brescia. She recognized that disorders of society were caused, because the education of young girls was neglected. In 1524 she went on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. On the island of Crete she suddenly became blind, but continued her journey. On the way back she prayed before a Crucifix at the same place where she became blind a few week before and received her sight back. During the jubilee year 1525 she traveled to Rome to gain indulgences. Pope Clement VII, having heard of her holiness and success as teacher in religion, invited Angela to remain in Rome, but she, shunning publicity, returned to Brescia. On the 25<sup>th</sup> of November 1535 Angela chose 12 virgins and laid the foundation of the Ursuline Order. This Orders object being the Christian education of youth, which she placed under the patronage of St. Ursula, patron of virgins. After serving 5 years as Superior, of the new Order, she died 1540 with the name of Jesus on her lips. 1807 Pope Pius VII added her name to the calendar of Saints.
