SAINT ALOYSIUS GONZAGA

Patron of Catholic Youth



St. Aloysius, son of Ferdinand, Marquis of Castiglione (Italy) was connected with all the royal houses. From a very young age St. Aloysius devoted himself heart and soul to the service of his creator. At fourteen years of age he accompanied his father to Spain, where he was made page to Prince James by Philip II. His innocence remained uncontaminated amid the vanities of the court, nor could the world draw his heart from God. In the year 1585, in spite of great opposition, he gave up his rights as eldest son and joined the Jesuits in Rome. From the beginning of his religious life St. Aloysius was a model of perfection. He hoped to go to the missions, but when the plague broke out in 1591, he distinguished himself by his charity toward the sick and dying in the hospital. He caught the plague himself and died on June 21st, 1591 at the age of 23, but his zeal for God, both as young man and as a prince remained an inspiration and example for all. St. Aloysius was canonized in 1726.

Father of love, giver of all good things, in Saint Aloysius you combined remarkable innocence with the spirit of penance. By the help of his prayers may we who have not followed his innocence follow his example of penance. Amen.

June 23<sup>rd</sup>  
**BIRTH OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST**

On this feast day, one of the oldest in the liturgy of the Church, we commemorate the birth of St. John, whose birth was foretold by an Angel and who was born 6 months before our Lord. He was the son of Zechariah and Elizabeth, a cousin of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He is considered the greatest and last prophet of the Old Testament. His purpose was to prepare the way and announce the coming of the long expected Messiah, the Redeemer. While the feast of other Saints is celebrated on the day of their death, the day of their final victory; St. John the Baptist's feast day is his birthday, as he was born free from original sin.

*God, our Father, You raised up John the Baptist to prepare a perfect people for Christ the Lord. Give Your Church joy in spirit and guide those who believe in You into the way of salvation and peace. Amen.*

**THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI**

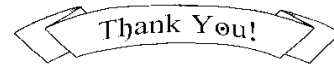
The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a Roman Catholic a liturgical solemnity celebrating the Real Presence of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the elements of the Eucharist. Two months earlier, the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper is observed on Holy Thursday in a sombre atmosphere leading to Good Friday. The liturgy on that day also commemorates Christ's washing of the disciples' feet and the institution of the priesthood.



The feast of Corpus Christi was proposed by Thomas Aquinas, Doctor of the Church, to Pope Urban IV, in order to create a feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist, emphasizing the joy of the Eucharist being the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ The pontiff established the feast of Corpus Christi as a Solemnity to be celebrated in the Roman Catholic Church.

The feast is liturgically celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday or, "where the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is not a holy day of obligation, it is assigned to the Sunday after the Most Holy Trinity as its proper day".
