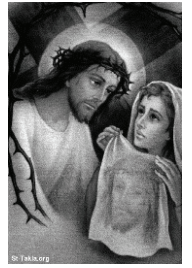

SAINT VERONICA



There is no mention of Veronica in the Gospels, yet we have come to know the story of a woman, who moved by compassion, wiped Jesus sweaty and bloody face, as he made his way to Calvary. Legend has it, that the impression of Christ's face was miraculously left on her handkerchief and that she took it to Rome and left it to Pope Clement. We recall Veronica's brave action at the sixth Station of the Cross. Her name actually means true image.

O Lord, let St. Veronica, who by her brave action, showed the world her love and compassion for Your Son, intercede for us, that we too have the courage to do what is pleasing to You . Amen.



July 14th

SAINT KATERI TEKAKWITHA

Kateri was born near the town of Auriesville, New York, in the year 1656. She was the daughter of a Mohawk warrior. Kateri was 4 years old when her mother died of small-pox. The disease also attacked Kateri and transfigured her face.

She was adopted by her two aunts and an uncle. Kateri became converted as teenager and was baptized at the age of twenty. She incurred the great hostility of her tribe. She suffered greatly for her Faith, but remained firm in it. Kateri went to the new Christian colony of Indians in Canada. Here she lived a life dedicated to prayer and the care of the aged and sick. She was devoted to the Eucharist and to Jesus Crucified. She died April 7th, 1680 at the age of 24. Kateri is known as the "Lily of the Mohawks".

Kateri Tekakwitha took a vow of perpetual **virginity**. Upon her death at the age of 24, witnesses said that her scars vanished minutes later, and her face appeared radiant and beautiful. Known for her **virtue** of chastity as well as being shunned by some of her tribe for her religious conversion to Catholicism, she is the fourth Native American to be venerated in the Catholic Church. Kateri was beatified in 1980 by Pope John Paul II, and canonized by Pope Benedict XVI at Saint Peter's Basilica on 21 October 2012. Various miracles and supernatural events are attributed to her intercession.

Lord, You called the Virgin, Blessed Kateri, to shine forth among the Indian people as an example of purity of life. Grant, through her intercession, that all people of every nation, tribe and tongue, may be gathered into Your Church and proclaim Your greatness in one song of praise. Amen.

July 15th,

ST. BONAVENTURE

Doctor of the Church and Patron of one of our Elementary Schools.



St. Bonaventure, known as the "Angelic Doctor" was born 1221 in Tuscany, of pious parents. He was baptized Giovanni (John) after his father. Legend has it that he received the name Bonaventure (Good Fortune) in

consequence of an exclamation by St. Francis of Assisi who cured him miraculously of a dangerous illness and foreseeing the future greatness of little Giovanni cried out "O buona ventura".

At age 21 St. Bonaventure entered the Franciscan Order and had such great influence, that he has been called its second founder. He was sent to Paris to complete his studies where he received the degree of Doctor of Theology together St. Thomas Aquinas who was his friend.

At age 35 St. Bonaventure was chosen minister general of his Order. He composed the Life of St. Francis. He became Cardinal and Bishop of Albano, one of the six Sees of Rome. He died while he was assisting Pope Gregory X at the fourteenth ecumenical council of Lyons, called to bring about the reunion of the Greek and Latin rites and the liberation of the Holy Land. He was canonized in 1482 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1588.

Almighty God, as we celebrate the heavenly birthday of St. Bonaventure, let us benefit from his wonderful teaching and be inspired by his burning charity. Amen.

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

This is the patronal feast of the Carmelites. Mount Carmel was the first place dedicated to the Blessed Virgin and where a chapel was erected in her honour before her Assumption into heaven. The Order of Carmelites takes its name from Mount Carmel and dates back to a group of Western hermits who in the 12th century settled on Mount Carmel, overlooking the plain of Galilee, in imitation of the prophet Elijah (see 1 Kings 18:19-46 and 2 Kings 2:25) they grouped themselves around that small chapel. In the 13th century, the Order of Carmel as we know it was formed.

This is also the feast of the "Scapular of Mount Carmel." On that day in 1251, pious tradition says, the Blessed Virgin appeared to St. Simon Stock, General of the Carmelites at Cambridge, England, showed him the scapular and promised supernatural favors and her special protection to his Order and to all persons who would wear her scapular. - To obtain the indulgences and other benefits promised to those who wear the Carmelite scapular, a person must be invested by a priest who has the requisite faculties, and must lead a consistent Christian life.

Lord, let the motherly prayer of the glorious Virgin Mary come to our help. Through her support help us to reach the true mount, which is Christ. Amen.
