



ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI



knight. Assisi' solders were defeated and Francis was held prisoner for a year and was sick for an other year after his release. He still saw himself as a soldier and was on his way to join the papal forces, when he had a dream in which he was told to "follow the master and not the man". He interpreted this as a call from Christ, turned back to Assisi and began to care for the poor, the sick and the lepers. Francis abandoned his affluent way of life and began to live a life of radical poverty. Worn out by his tremendous apostolic efforts, pained by the stigmata he received in 1224, blinded by eye disease and suffering from acute stomach disorders, he died October 3rd, 1226. With his simplicity and directness, by his love for God and man, as well as all God's creatures, Francis has captured the heart and imagination of men of all religious persuasions.

Father, You helped Saint Francis to reflect the image of Christ through a life of poverty and humility. May we follow Your Son by walking in the footsteps of St. Francis of Assisi, and by imitating his joyful love. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

October 5th

SAINT MARY FAUSTINA

Saint Mary Faustina Kowalska was born in Glogowiec in Poland August 25th, 1905 and was baptized in the parish church with the name Helena. At the age of nine she made her first holy

communion. From an early age she wanted to enter a convent, but the parents did not give their permission and she worked as housekeeper supporting herself and her family. August 1st, 1925 she had a vision of the suffering Christ and entered the congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy taking the name

Mary Faustina. She spent the rest of her life, only 13 years in the Congregation's houses as cook, gardener and porter. Sister Mary Faustina exterior demeanor hid the extraordinary union with God. She based her spirituality on the mystery of the Mercy of God, which she saw in the word of God as well as in her everyday life. From the beginning of its existence the Church preached the mercy of God and God in His Divine Mercy gave us Sister Mary Faustina as a reminder of it. Sister Mary Faustina suffered from tuberculosis and other ailments. She died at the age of 33 on October 5, 1939. She was beatified April 18th, 1993 by Pope John Paul II and was canonized by him April 30th, 2000. The Sunday after Easter was proclaimed "Divine Mercy Sunday" in the year

FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY ROSARY

His Holiness Pope Leo XII decreed that the month of October be called the month of the Most Holy Rosary. Tradition asserts that, after St. Dominic

implored the holy Mother of God to enlighten him how he could bring about the conversion of misguided souls

for whom her Divine Son had laid down His life, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to him holding a rosary and instructed him how to say it. When the Mohammedans were threatening to overrun Christian Europe, Pope Pius V asked all Christians to recite the Holy Rosary for the success of the Christian Arms, and ordered all Churches to conduct Devotions with public processions and recitation of the Rosary. On Sunday, October 7, 1571, Don Johann of Austria gained naval victory over the Turkish fleet at Lepano, while processions of the confraternities of the Holy Rosary were taking place in Rome. Don Johann of Austria ascribed the victory to the powerful intercession of the Oueen of the Most Holy Rosary. In thanksgiving St. Pius V declared October 7th, the Feast of the most Holy Rosary. *****************


