ST. ANTONY MARY CLARET

Helper of those suffering from cancer, heart trouble, and other serious ailments of soul and body

St. Antony was born in Catalonia, Spain in 1807 and became a weaver like his father. In his spare time he studied Latin and printing. In 1829 he

entered the seminary at Vic and was ordained into the diocesan clergy in 1835, but longed to belong to a religious Order. In 1849 he founded the Congregation of Missionary Sons of the Immaculate Heart of Mary or Claretians. In 1850 St. Antony was appointed Archbishop of Santiago in Cuba. He added the name Mary at his consecration taking her as "my Mother, my Protector, my teacher." He brought reform to clergy and laity in his diocese He established many new parishes and restored the seminary. In 1857 he returned to Spain and became confessor to Oueen Isabella and oversaw the activities of his congregation. In the revolution of 1868 Queen Isabella was forced off the throne and Antony went with her into exile. He sought refuge at a Cistercian Monastery in France where he died October 24, 1870 and was beatified 1934 and canonized in 1950.


His teaching: "Choose now what you would wish to have chosen at life's end."


SAINTS SIMON AND JUDE Apostles
