ST. ANTONY MARY CLARET

Helper of those suffering from cancer, heart trouble, and other serious ailments of soul and body



St. Antony was born in Catalonia, Spain in 1807 and became a weaver like his father. In his spare time he studied Latin and printing. In 1829 he entered the seminary at Vic and was ordained into the diocesan clergy in 1835, but longed to belong to a religious Order. In 1849 he founded the Congregation of Missionary Sons of the Immaculate Heart of Mary or Claretians. In 1850 St. Antony was appointed Archbishop of Santiago in Cuba. He added the name Mary at his consecration taking her as "my Mother, my Protector, my teacher." He brought reform to clergy and laity in his diocese. He established many new parishes and restored the seminary. In 1857 he returned to Spain and became confessor to Queen Isabella and oversaw the activities of his congregation. In the revolution of 1868 Queen Isabella was forced off the throne and Antony went with her into exile. He sought refuge at a Cistercian Monastery in France where he died October 24, 1870 and was beatified 1934 and canonized in 1950.

His teaching: "Choose now what you would wish to have chosen at life's end."

St. Anthony Mary Claret, during your life on earth you often comforted the afflicted and showed such tender love and compassion for the sick and sinful Intercede for me now that you rejoice in the reward of your virtues in heavenly glory. Look with pity on me (or on the person afflicted or whose conversion is desired) and grant my prayer, if such be the will of God. Make my troubles your own. Speak a word for me to the Immaculate Heart of Mary to obtain by her powerful intercession the grace I yearn for so ardently, and a blessing to strengthen me during life, assist me at the hour of death, and lead me to a happy eternity. Amen.

SAINTS SIMON AND JUDE

Apostles



ST. SIMON is surnamed the Canaanean and also the Zealot, referring to his zeal for the Law and to distinguish him from Simon Peter. He was the brother of St. James the Less. It is supposed that he suffered martyrdom in Persia.

ST. JUDE, known as Thaddaeus, was a relative of our Lord and Saviour. Ancient writers tell us, that he preached the Gospel in Judea, Samaria, Idumaea, Syria, Mesopotamia and Lybia. St. Jude is said to have suffered Martyrdom in Armenia, which at that time was subject to Persia. The nation Armenia did not convert to Christianity till the 3rd Century. St. Jude is well known as the Patron of desperate and hopeless cases.

Father, You revealed Yourself to us through the preaching of Your Apostles Simon and Jude. By their prayers, give Your Church continued growth, and increase the number of those who believe in You. Amen.

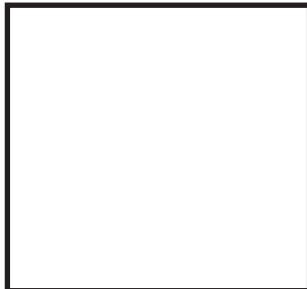
PRAYER FOR PEACE IN THE WORLD
