EPIPHANY



Epiphany, a Greek word, meaning “Appearance or manifestation”, is the Feast of the Manifestation of the Child Jesus to the Gentiles. Jesus, the Word made flesh on Christmas day, was known to only a few. To Mary and Joseph, to the shepherds and to their friend who would believe. He was hidden from the world.

Three Magi, gentiles, had seen a star and without hesitation were ready to follow call of the newborn King of the Jews. Doubts as to the meaning of the star and complaints about the great distance found no place in their hearts or minds. BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Jesus came to John the Baptist at the river Jordan, to be baptized by him. John, who new Jesus to be the Messiah, expressed the need to be baptized by Jesus. **STS. JULIAN AND BASILISSA**

Saints Julian and Basiliss, though married, lived in perpetual chastity by mutual consent.

They turned their home in Egypt into a hospital in order to help the poor and the sick. Basilissa cared for the women and Julian took care of the men. At times they housed a thousand destitute people. Basilissa died after suffering severe persecution. Julian received his crown of martyrdom during the reign of Maximin II in 313 many years after Basilissa did. There are many churches in the East and West bearing one or the other of these Martyrs. During the time of St. Gregory the Great, (6<sup>th</sup> century) St. Julian's skull was brought from the East to France and given to Queen Brunehault; she gave it to the convent which she founded. Later part of the skull was presented to the monastery of Morigny and part to the church of the Regular Canonesses of Balilissa in Paris.

**SAINT MARGUERITE BOURGEOYS**



Marguerite was born in Troyes, France in 1620. She was the sixth of twelve children. She sought to enter the religious life when she was twenty years old, but for some reason was rejected by both the Carmelites and the Poor Clairs. On the advice of a priest she formed a group of "extern Sisters" with other young women. They taught children in poor districts in Troyes. This was however discouraged by the religious authorities. Her opportunity to follow her missionary calling came in 1653, when the French settlement of Ville-Marie, now Montreal, was in need of a schoolmistress. In October 1653 she was at her post, where she was looking after children, worked in hospitals, assisted couples preparing for marriage introduced vocational courses and so became the soul of the settlement. In 1570 she went back to France to inspire more young women to teach in the new world. She with fellow teachers formed the Congregation of Notre Dame. They worked wherever they were needed. Today members of the community she formed work in many parts of the world. Marguerite was canonized in 1982.

*Almighty God, You called Saint Marguerite of Bourgeoys to leave her homeland and educate the young in the Christian Faith. By her example and prayer, direct our words and deeds, that we may walk in Your ways and proclaim the loving presence of the Word made flesh among us. Amen.*
