SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

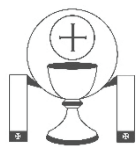

January 17<sup>th</sup>

**SAINTE ANTHONY**

Founder of Monasticism, Patron of Gravediggers.



Saint Anthony was born in 251 in Upper Egypt into a rich and virtuous Christian family. While still a young man he lost both his parents. Following the words of Christ to the rich young man: "Go, and sell all you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." After dividing all his possessions among the poor he retired into the desert, where he lived the life of a hermit, devoting himself to silence, prayer and manual labour. After years of solitude, he emerged to found a religious community in 305 at the age of 55. This was the beginning of Christian monasticism. Saint Anthony died, peacefully in the Lord in 356 at the age of 105.

*Father, You called Saint Anthony to renounce the world and serve You in the solitude of the desert. By his prayers and example, may we learn to deny ourselves and to love You above all things.*

January 21<sup>st</sup>

**ST. AGNES**



St. Agnes was probably born in the early years of the 4<sup>th</sup> century and martyred at the age of 12 during the Roman persecution. She is a symbol of virginal innocence and is the most highly regarded of the Roman martyrs.

The young noblemen of Rome, attracted by her wealth and beauty, vied with one another to obtain her hand in marriage, but she refused them all, saying that she had chosen a Spouse who could not be seen by mortal eyes. In the hope of shaking her constancy, her suitors accused her of being a Christian. She was brought before a judge. She remained unswayed by either his kindness or his threats. She was tortured and sent to a house of prostitution, but the sight of her inspired such awe, that not one of the wicked youths dared approach her. St. Agnes came forth from this den uncontaminated in mind and body – still the pure spouse of Christ. The most prominent of her suitors brought more charges against her and so the heroic Virgin was condemned to be beheaded. St. Ambrose said that Agnes went to the place of execution more cheerful than others go to their wedding. St. Agnes went to meet her Immortal Spouse, whom she loved better than her life, while onlookers wept.

*All-powerful and ever-living God, You choose the weak in this world to put the powerful to shame. As we celebrate the anniversary of the martyrdom of St. Agnes, may we like her remain constant in faith. Amen.*

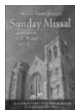
