ST. PETER DAMIAN

Bishop and Doctor of the Church

In 1007 St. Peter Damian was born in Ravenna, Italy into an extreme poor, large family. He was the youngest child. When



his parents died Peter was still a young child and as it was at that time, he was placed with his oldest, married brother, who treated him so cruelly, that his brother Damian, who was a priest took him in. Damian showed fatherly love towards him and had him educated. Peter showed his great gratitude by adding his brother's name, Damian, to his own. Peter Damian excelled in his studies and became a renowned teacher. About 1035, displeased with the scandals at universities, he resolved to join the monks at Font-Avellano. In 1043 he was made Superior and held this office until his death in 1072. His wisdom and sanctity was remarkable. He engaged in many delicate missions, which he achieved by his zeal. 7 Popes he served as advisor. In 1057 Pope Stephen IX consecrated, this humble man in spite of his objections, Cardinal Bishop of Ostia. Peter Damian laboured in defense of Alexander II against Antipope Benedict X, whom he forced to yield and ask for pardon.

He settled discords amongst various Bishops and reconciled Ravenna to the Holy See in 1072. Days after he was seized with fever and after a week of illness he died in the monastery Santa Maria Vecchia, as the Monks, standing around his bed, finished chanting Lauds. 1823 Pope Leo XII pronounced St. Peter Damian a Doctor of the Church.

Almighty God, grant that those of us whom You have firmly rooted with a strong foundation in the apostolic profession may not be shaken by the hesitations of the world. Amen


Ashes will be blessed and distributed at the 7:30 a.m. Morning Mass and at the 7:00 p.m. Evening Mass.

All-powerful Father, You have built Your Church on the rock of St. Peter's confession of faith. May nothing divide or weaken our unity in faith and love. Amen.

Ash Wednesday probably dates from at least the eighth century and occurs forty days before Easter. Even though Ash Wednesday in not a day of obligation, practicing Catholics will attend Mass. On this day the faithful, according to ancient custom, approach the altar where the priest, dipping his thumb into previously blessed ashes,



marks the forehead of each with the sign of the cross, saying the words: "Remember, mortal, you are dust and to dust you will return" or "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel". The ashes used in this ceremony are made by burning palms, which were blessed on Palm Sunday of the previous year, when we commemorated Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem by waving palms. And so by using these palms, we should remember that we must not only rejoice in Jesus' coming but also regret the fact that our sinfulness made it necessary for Him to die for us in order to save us from eternal condemnation. The reception of this sacramental, is full with symbolism of penance. All through the books of Law, both Old and New, men who repented their sins covered themselves with or sat in ashes and clothed themselves with sackcloth. For us too, getting signed with the cross of ashes, is the acknowledgement of our sinfulness and need of repentance. ************
