SAINTS PERPETUA AND FELICITY

Martyrs



St. Perpetua was a 22 year old noble lady of Carthage with a baby son and St. Felicity was a married slave who was pregnant. They and 3 fellow Christians were arrested under the anti-Christian edict of the year 202. All had been converted by a layman, Saturus, who joined them voluntarily in the dungeon where they were imprisoned for refusing to sacrifice to the gods. Perpetua yielded her child to her father but remained firm in her Faith. Felicity gave birth in prison. She also remained steadfast in the Faith even when her baby was taken away from her.

St. Perpetua, St. Felicity and Saturninus, Secundulus Revocatus and Saturus, their teacher, were condemned to death. They were mauled by beasts in the amphitheater before finally being beheaded.

Father, inspired by Your love Sts. Perpetua and Felicity were able to disregard persecution and overcome the torment of death. Aided by their prayers, may we make contestant progress in our love for You. Amen.

SAINT JOHN OF GOD

Patron of Hospitals and the Sick

John was born in Portugal on March 8, 1495 of humble but virtuous parents. His early years were spent as a shepherd. 1522 he enlisted in a military company. Evil associations caused his spirit of piety to decline. Wracked by guilt over his wasted life, he sought the counsel of John of Avila, a preacher and missionary, who helped him find a new purpose in life. John of God dedicated himself to the care of the sick and the poor. Others joined him and they became known as the Order of Brothers Hospitallers or Brothers of St. John of God. John died on his birthday in 1550 and was canonized in 1690.

God You filled St. John with the spirit of compassion. Grant that we also live by Your commandment of love. Amen.

March 9th

SAINT FRANCES OF ROME

Patroness of widows.



St. Frances was born in Rome in 1384 into a noble family. She wished to enter a convent at the age of twelve, but obediently, according to the wishes of her parents, she married a wealthy nobleman by the name Lawrence Ponziani. In marriage she led a pious life, but never let her spiritual exercises interfere with her domestic duties. She endured many trials. She bore 3 children, of which 2 died in infancy. During the great schism her husband was banished. She however suffered with exemplary patience blessing the will of God. She looked after others who were grieving and looked after their needs, after the schism her husband recovered his estates. In 1424 she founded the Oblate Congregation of Tor di Specchi, to which she gave the rule of St. Benedict. In 1437, after the death of her husband she received the habit and began to live as if she was

the lowest of all the sisters, still she was chosen mother superior. She died March 9th, 1440, at the age of 56 and was canonized in 1608.

God, in St. Frances You have given us a singular example of both the monastic and the conjugal way of life. Help us to persevere in serving You so that in all the ups and downs of life we may both look to You and follow You. Amen.

THE ARCHDIOCESE WILL SOON HAVE A NEW ARCHBISHOP!

Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Francis (Frank) Leo, currently Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Montreal, as the 14th Archbishop of Toronto.



He will succeed Cardinal Thomas Collins, After the installation ceremony at St. Michael's Cathedral Bishop Leo will begin his assignment as shepherd of Canada's largest Catholic diocese,

Born in Montreal in 1971 to Italian immigrant parents, Frank Leo entered the Grand Séminaire de Montréal in 1990 and was ordained a priest for service to the Archdiocese on December 14, 1996. Father Leo served in different parish assignments in Montreal until 2006 when he accepted the invitation to enroll in the Pontifical Ecclesiastical Academy in Rome and subsequently enter the Diplomatic Service of the Holy See (2006-2012) serving in different Apostolic Nunciatures across the globe. In January 2012, Pope Benedict XVI appointed him Chaplain of His Holiness bestowing the title of Monsignor. Upon his return to Canada, Monsignor Leo joined the formation team of the Grand Séminaire de Montréal, teaching theology and philosophy while providing spiritual direction, training and accompaniment to candidates for the priesthood. In the fall of 2015, he was appointed General Secretary of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB), a mandate which came to an end in the fall of 2021. As of February 1, 2022, Monsignor Leo was named Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia of the Archdiocese of Montreal. On July 16, 2022, Pope Francis appointed him as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Montreal. His consecration as a bishop took place on September 12, 2022. Archbishop-designate Leo holds a Doctorate in Systematic Theology, and a Licentiate Philosophy with a specialization in Mariology, a Diploma in Classical Studies and a Graduate Certificate in Spiritual Direction. In 2015, he was appointed General Secretary of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, a mandate which he held till 2021. As of February 1, 2022, Monsignor Leo was named Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia of the Archdiocese of Montreal. On July 16, 2022, Pope Francis appointed him as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Montreal. His consecration as a bishop took place on September 12, 2022. Bishop Francis Leo He speaks English, French, Italian and Spanish.
