SAINT PHILIP AND SAINT JAMES Apostles of Jesus



ST. PHILIP was called by Jesus the day after St. Peter and St. Andrew. He left all things to follow Christ. St. Philip is frequently mentioned in the Holy Gospels.



ST. JAMES (called 'James the Less' because he was younger than the other apostle James) He was the son Alphaeus and Mary, who was either a sister or a close relative of the Blessed Virgin, and for that reason, according to Jewish custom, he was sometimes called

the brother of the Lord. He is mentioned in Mark and in Acts, and is the author of the first canonical epistle. He was called a pillar of the Church. St. James died a martyr's death by stoning about the year 62.

Lord God we enjoy celebrating the annual feast of Your apostles Saints Philip and James. Through their prayers let us share in the suffering, death and resurrection of Your only Son and come to the eternal vision of Your glory. Amen.


