Pope John Paul II placed it in the Catechism of the Catholic Church and Pope Francis added a feast by this title into the Roman Calendar in 2018. This feast commemorates the visit of the Blessed Virgin Mary to St. Elizabeth. At the time when Angel Gabriel told Mary, that she will conceive by the Holy Spirit, he also told her that her aged cousin, who was said to be barren, is expecting. Mary went to see Elizabeth and the two


