In Trinitarian doctrine, God exists as three persons, but is one being, having a single divine nature. The members of the Trinity are co-equal and co-

eternal, one in essence, nature, power, action, and will. the Father is uncreated, the Son is uncreated, and the Holy Spirit is uncreated, and all three are eternal without beginning. "The Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit" are not names for different parts of God, but one name for God because three persons exist in God as one entity. They cannot be separated from one another. Each person is understood as having the identical essence or nature, not merely similar natures

Baptism is generally conferred with the Trinitarian formula, "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit".

Glory be to the Father, Who by His almighty power and love created me, making me in the image and likeness of God. Glory be to the Son, Who by His Precious Blood delivered me from hell, and opened for me the gates of Heaven.

Glory be to the Holy Spirit, Who has sanctified me in the sacrament of Baptism, and continues to sanctify me by the graces I receive daily from His bounty.

Glory be to the Three adorable Persons of the Holy Trinity, and forever. Amen. *******************

SAINT BONIFACE

Bishop and Martyr, Apostle of Germany

St. Boniface was born in the year 680 in Devonshire, England and was baptized Winfrid. From the age of 13 he was educated in the Benedictine Monastery and by 717 he was a renowned teacher and preacher. At the age of 30 he was ordained to the priesthood. He gave up his work to answer a call to work



in the mission field, which took him to Friesland, Netherlands. His first attempt was not successful and he returned to England. In 719 he went to Rome presented himself to Pope Gregory II, and asked permission to teach the idolaters. The Pope gave him permission to teach the Faith to the heathens in Germany. The Pope also gave him the Name Boniface He established a number of dioceses in Germany, but chose Mainz as his Episcopal See. He ended his fruitful career by a glorious martyrdom in Friesland, where he had returned to teach the Faith.

Legend has it that it was in Germany, after St. Boniface witnessed the worship of an oak tree by pagan people, he got angry and cut the tree down and in the oak's roots a tiny fir tree sprung. St. Boniface took it as a sign of the Christian Faith replacing pagan worship.

Lord, let St. Boniface intercede for us, that we may be loyal to the Faith he taught and for which he shed his blood. Give us also the courage to fearlessly profess our faith in our works. Amen. ****************

JUNE: A FEAST OF FEASTS

The month of June brings us significant liturgical solemnities. We celebrate the Sacred Heart of Jesus, an event that felicitously unites this popular devotion with theological depth. It was traditional, and some countries, still is, to consecrate families to the Sacred Heart, whose image they would keep in their homes. The devotion is rooted in the mystery of the Incarnation; it is precisely through the Heart of Jesus that the Love of God for humanity is sublimely manifested.

This is why authentic devotion to the Sacred Heart has retained all its effectiveness and especially attracts souls thirsting for God's mercy who find in it the inexhaustible source from which to draw the water of Life that can irrigate the deserts of the soul arid make hope flourish anew. The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is also the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests:

I take the opportunity to invite all of you, dear brothers and sisters to pray for priests always so that they will be effective witnesses of Christ's love.

We also celebrate the Birth of St John the Baptist, the only Saint whose birth is commemorated because it marked the beginning of the fulfillment of the divine promises: John is that 'prophet,' identified with Elijah, who was destined to be the immediate precursor of the Messiah, to prepare the people of Israel for his coming. His feast reminds us that our life is entirely and always 'relative' to Christ and is fulfilled by accepting Him, the Word, the Light and the Bridegroom. "He must increase, but I must decrease" (John 3.30): the Baptist's words are a program for every Christian.

Allowing the "I" of Christ to replace our "I" was in an exemplary way the desire of the Apostles Peter and Paul, whom the Church solemnly venerates on June 29. Saint Paul wrote of himself: "It is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me" (Galatians 2.20).

Before them and before any other saint, it was Mary Most Holy who lived this reality and cherished in her heart the words of her Son Jesus. We contemplate her Immaculate Heart, the heart of a mother that continues to watch tenderly over us all. May her intercession enable us to remain ever faithful to our Christian vocation.




