REFLECTION on the 12th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR B In the Storm

Do you not yet have faith? Our Lord's question in today's Gospel frames the Sunday liturgies for the remainder of the year, which the Church calls Ordinary Time.

In the weeks ahead, the Church's liturgy will have us journeying with Jesus and His disciples, reliving their experience of His words and deeds, coming to know and believe in Him as they did.

Notice that today's Psalm almost provides an outline for the Gospel. We sing of sailors caught in a storm; in their desperation, they call to the Lord and He rescues them.

Mark's Gospel today also intends us to hear a strong echo of the story of the prophet Jonah. He, too, was found asleep on a boat when a life-threatening storm broke out that caused his fellow travelers to pray for deliverance, and then to marvel when the storm abated (see Jonah 1:3-16).

But Jesus is something greater than Jonah (see Matthew 12:41). And Mark wants us to come to see what the Apostles saw—that God alone has the power to rebuke the wind and the sea (see Isaiah 50:2; Psalm 18:16). This is the point of today's First Reading.

If even the wind and sea obey Him, shouldn't we trust Him in the chaos and storms of our own lives?

As with the Apostles, the Lord has asked each of us to cross to the other side, to leave behind our old ways to travel with Him in the little ship of the Church.

In their fear today, they call Him, Teacher. And it is only faith in His teaching that can save us from perishing. We should trust in Christ, and trust like Christ—who was able to sleep through the storm, confident that God was with Him (see Psalm 116:6; Romans 8:31).

We should live in thanksgiving for our salvation, as today's Epistle tells us—as new creations, no longer for ourselves but for Him who died for our sake.

My beloved Parishioners

It has been 17 years that I was with you. I came to Brampton in June 2007 to organize and build the new Church for you. The beginning was very difficult. I had to start everything from scratch.

I started Masses at St. Leonard Church, thanks to Fr. Andrew Maderak hospitality, who allowed me to have all the Sacraments at his Church. Later, with the permission of the Catholic School Board I started Masses in the chapel at St. Edmund Campion Secondary School.

At the beginning, I had only few people attending the morning Masses in the school Chapel.

Slowly and gradually the news about the new parish in Brampton was spread among the people. The new people were joining the parish. The Congregation was growing, slowly and gradually after few months being in the Chapel, we had to move to the cafeteria because Chapel in the school was too small to accommodate growing congregation. We spent 7 years at the school cafeteria, saying the Masses, organizing some events and fundraising for our new church. With support of the good people like you, we decided to build parish hall for gathering and organizing more events to raise more funds for our future church. Even children were involved with the fundraising, they had auction selling the pictures in the schools, collecting Canadian Tire money, or selling daily Brampton newspaper. The support from all of you was tremendous and thanks to all of you who were at the beginning of the new parish. In 2013 we got permission from the Toronto Diocese to build our dream, the new church of Guardian Angels. It took us only one year to build. After many requirements from the City of Brampton and the Toronto Diocese we have right now the beautiful building and spiritual community to say Mass and pray to Almighty God who is among us. The new Church was consecrated on October 6, 2019.

Firstly, I would like to thank God that He gave me the opportunity to build the House of God, Secondly, I would like to express my gratitude to you Good People of Guardian Angels Parish that you were with me and supported me from the beginning. With people like you we can do impossible things possible.

I am grateful to all of you for your unending generosity to build the beautiful Church.

Right now, I am asking you to accept the new pastor who is coming after me. His name is Fr. Ravi Babu Kakumanu. I hope he will continue the God's work in this Church. So far, we have about 3500 families registered in the parish. But this area is growing drastically. Every Sunday new people want to register and attend Mass.

It's hard to say good buy to you. Through these 17 years we had good and bad times to build this beautiful church but most important it is to build spiritual community. We did it together. I thank God and you Good People of this parish. I leave you under the protection of Divine Mercy, Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, and St. Joseph whose picture we have in the church. May the Holy Family and the Guardian Angels protect you always and direct you and your families to Jesus Our Lord. God Bless all of you.

Pray for me and my new parish the Nativity of Our Lord that I am assigned to serve with God's will.
