LENTEN JOURNEY WITH THE WORD

Dear friends we've reached that time of year when the Church invites us, over the next few weeks, to join in a special way with Our Lord. We remember how opposition to His teachings grew, leading to His death, and how He rose from the dead three days later. This period, known as Lent in English (a word derived from the Middle English term meaning 'daylengthening' or springtime), is referred to in German as Fastenzeit (a time of fasting), in French as carême, in Italian as quaresima, and in Spanish as cuaresma. All of these terms come from the Latin quadragesima, meaning 'fortieth.' Together, these names define Lent as the Church's traditional forty-day period of fasting and penance in preparation for Easter.

In the early Church, this was the time when adult candidates for baptism were instructed and prepared to join the faithful at the Easter Vigil. It was also a time when, before the practice of private confession, serious sinners did penance and were reconciled with the Church at Easter. Over time, this period of preparation and penance expanded to include all the faithful, becoming a penitential season for everyone in the Church. It became a time for spiritual renewal and a preparation to celebrate Christ's resurrection at Easter.

The forty days of Lent were meant to mirror the forty days and nights Jesus spent in prayer and fasting in the desert before beginning His public ministry (Luke 4:1-2). This period also draws inspiration from the forty days Moses and Elijah spent in prayer, as well as the forty years the Israelites spent in the desert, preparing to receive the Promised Land.

As part of our spiritual renewal during this Lenten journey I invite you all to learn a bible verse each day of the lent. In Ps 119:105, the psalmist says that the word of God is the light to our feet and a lamp to our path. By learning the bible verse let us light up our path towards the spiritual renewal.

I am providing you with bible verses to ponder and learn each day throughout the 40 days of Lent.

Repentance and Renewal

March 5: Joel 2:12 – "Even now," declares the Lord, "return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning."

March 6: Psalm 51:10 – "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me."

March 7: Matthew 4:4 – "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."

March 8: Isaiah 58:6 – "Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke?"

March 9: Mark 1:15 – "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

March 10: Romans 12:2 – "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind."

March 11: 2Chronicles 7:14 – "If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven."

March 12: Matthew 6:6 – "But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret."

March 13: Matthew 6:16 – "When you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by others."

March 14: Isaiah 58:11 – "The Lord will guide you continually and satisfy your desire in scorched places."

March 15: Philippians 4:6 – "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God."
