SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

What is Spiritual Communion?
Spiritual Communion is a way to be united with
Christ when we are not able to physically receive
the Eucharist. St. Thomas Aquinas described it as
"an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Holy
Sacrament, and a loving embrace as though we
had already received Him." This was a practice
very dear to the heart of St. Alphonsus Liguori,
founder of the Redemptorists. In this time of

"social distancing," let's use St. Alphonsus' practice to be united in spirit and in prayer with one another and with Christ.

How to make a Spiritual Communion.

- Start with the Sign of the Cross
- Read and reflect on the readings for the day (you can go to https://readings.livingwithchrist.ca) or watch one of the many televised
 Masses or the one that is livestreamed or recorded by your home parish.
- Have a real desire to be united with Christ.
- Acknowledge your sins and ask for forgiveness.
- Pray an Act of Spiritual Communion, such as this one by St. Alphonsus Liquori
 - My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament.
 I love you above all things, and desire to receive you.
 Since I cannot, at this moment, receive you in the Sacrament, come spiritually into my heart.
 I embrace you, for You are already there, and unite myself totally to you. Amen.
 Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.
- Offer thanksgiving

O Mary, you shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope.

We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick. At the foot of the Cross you participated in Jesus' pain, with steadfast faith.

You, Salvation of the Roman People, know what we need. We are certain that you will provide, so that, as you did at Cana of Galilee, joy and feasting might return after this moment of trial.

Help us, Mother of Divine Love, to conform ourselves to the Father's will and to do what Jesus tells us: He who took our sufferings upon Himself, and bore our sorrows to bring us, through the Cross, to the joy of the Resurrection. Amen.
